ICAR-IIRMR Signs MoA with NAROTTAM SEEDS LLP for Licensing of Mustard Variety DRMRIJ-31 (GIRIRAJ)

The ICAR–Indian Institute of Rapeseed-Mustard Research (ICAR-IIRMR), Bharatpur, Rajasthan, signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with M/s NAROTTAM SEEDS LLP, Mohakampur, Phase 1, Meerut City, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh, on October 11, 2025, for the non-exclusive licensing of the Indian mustard variety DRMRIJ-31 (GIRIRAJ).

DRMRIJ-31 (GIRIRAJ) is a high-yielding and high oil content mustard variety, recommended for timely sown conditions in Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, and has also shown excellent performance in other mustard-growing regions.

The MoA was formally signed by Dr. V. V. Singh, Director, ICAR-IIRMR, Bharatpur, and Mr. Atulya Bandhu Gupta, Managing Director, M/s NAROTTAM SEEDS LLP, on behalf of their respective organizations.

In his address, Dr. V. V. Singh emphasized that the commercialization of high-yielding varieties will facilitate the expansion of improved varieties in farmers' fields, ultimately contributing towards India's goal of achieving self-sufficiency in edible oilseed production.
